 in fitting a new one this end ship heading S.W. light airs

 Wednesday one watch splitting up a bag of wood picked up at 4 pm
 August 9th finished top of yard and painted it with calms at 8 am
 took down boat to repair this end with calms

 August up top of yard ship calm at 2 am light airs from
 Thursday the South at daylight 3 sea in light better port came
 20 E & employed in repairing boat this end

 August boat and put her over head at 6 pm breeze from
 Saturday the South at 2 am wind increasing at 9 am

 Tuesday island of Pagan clearing dist 40 miles Middle
 August 12th air made all sail heading in packed up a bag 14 feet
 long 15 in ch square

 Wednesday 5 pm more ship to South under closed reef and three
 August 13th Standard at 7 am shute out the reef set
 4th one sail in light this end
