

Shook several vessels in sight at 8 pm
and strong breeze at 4 am left off
ship in falling off Shook at Annapolis
rather thick bound to Boston & End

weather capt went on shore to see about
charges to high come on board spoke
with Geo Spurr spoke before the ship
So triumphed ship strong breeze course SE this end
Latter squally wind west this end
South by 28 30

Sept 11th (Wed) Comm' with strong wind from west course SE at 4 pm saw
the island of Royal one Rico and several sails at 6 pm spoke
Sept 12th (Thurs) to the wind shifted and hauled about this end
and port strong wind at 9 am capt went on
shore ship leaving off on the sandwiree they were
Robert Morrison and John Malchman the same
the ship went at anchor under the smalla cenderbar
the day left ship went and left at anchor & End

Sept 13th (Fri) Comm' with strong breeze leaving off and on at 8 pm beat
Tuesdays came on board cooper came on board badly intoxicated
Sept 14th (Sat) carpenter do been on shore sick the last 20 days at 8 pm
Shook out for the night at 9 am in the Passage End
beat on shore 6 vessels in sight this end

Sept 15th (Sun) Comm' squally weather at 4 pm capt came off this day
Sept 16th (Mon) discharged a sick Portugies without pay ship's crew
Sept 17th (Tues) King John's name at 6 pm left off 8 pm
light air latter part working up to St Georges island
for water this end

Sept 18th (Wed) Comm' with fine weather at 8 pm saw 8 ships ad marit
Sept 19th (Thurs) Blaker took a small whale along side no more whole
in sight ship leaving off and on latter came got
casks on deck ready for water & End

Sept 20th (Fri) Comm' with calm at 1 pm took rest on shore in
charge of Portugies to fill in the night at 7 am sent
Sept 21st (Sat) in two boats for the rest at 10 am got it on board
and stave off hawsers to secure this day shipped the goods

Sept 22nd (Sun) Comm' with strong breeze caught in steering water at
Saturday 3 pm finished at 4 pm the island dist 1 mile at
Sept 23rd (Mon) 6 pm started sail were ship heading to the west
with strong winds ship heavy squalls close reefed
saw rain at daylight then smothered and
all sail staving SE this end thick weather
Leak 18 10 Br 11

Sept 24th (Tues) Comm' with strong winds from the westward at 1 pm
saw the line bearing 5 miles dist 12 miles boats on the wind
Sept 25th (Wed) standing in at 1 pm took off at 4 pm took in at 6
pm took in light sail heading off shore at 9 am capt
went on shore at St Michaels at 9 am spoke ship
Gizella 18 days out then at Annapolis beat came off
with 20 barrels Potatoes this end

Sept 26th (Thurs) Comm' with light air ship leaving off and on at 8 pm
Sept 27th (Fri) capt came on board broke forward heading 3 at
Sept 28th (Sat) 11 pm took ship at 12 pm took again
at 7 am left off at 10 am spoke Bryan the
11 miles out 100 sperm one netch breaking out
after took this end more increasing
