 at 9 am began to paint thick weather the end
 Lat 35.50 " Long 12.40

(P.M.) (Sun) with steady breeze from N Employed in painting
 (Fri) at 3 pm finished try works at 4 pm quit painting for the
 November night took in light sails steaming 8 m from land and took
 thick foggy weather with light air from N East
 Lat same

(P.M.) (Sun) with thick foggy weather at 1 pm light breeze from
 (Sat) North East in fine strong steady breeze took thick
 November foggy weather finished in light the end
 Lat 35.25 " Long 12.00

(P.M.) (Sun) with thick weather light air from N East in fine
 (Sun) light breeze ship heading S daylight thick weather at 9 am clear
 November plenty fishbacks in sight at 10 am took heads on 3 m the end

 November (over under 9th) saw better caught some fish were ship heading S

 took part employed in filling water boat the end
 Lat 36.55 " Long 13.54

(P.M.) (Sun) with strong wind from N ship heading 88 m sail in light
 (Fri) at 4 pm saw 60 fish got quite a number of Whiting
 November and red perch at 8 pm came S this part strong wind from
 North East 8.20 came back off duty
 Lat 36.20 " Long 14.11

(P.M.) (Sun) with strong wind from N came S at 8 pm wind
 (Sat) light not at daylight sunset thick clear daylight as sail
 at 10 in light later fishbacks in light one watch getting out
 provisions the end light air from North
 Lat 36.50 " Long 14.50

(P.M.) (Sun) with light air from N came S at 8 pm one watch getting out water
 (Sun) at 6 pm weather looking squally took in light sails and
 Nov 20 squally daylight rain and hail 10 am ship head 358 S 8.3
 Lat 43.00 " Long 16.57

(P.M.) (Sun) with strong wind from East at 8 pm near ship heading
 (Mon) in 8 m at 6 pm moderating set fish in light breeze
 Nov 21 latter sun 9 m N came N 3 m
 Lat 43.14 " Long 17.00 " Long 17.00
