

Sept 16th Com^d with light airs and calms ship heading off
Friday) and on cruising for sperm whales and steering
generally 180° later steering 210° thick weather so end

Sept 17th Com^d with thick rainy weather ship heading on
Saturday) and strong breeze at daylight one sail in sight
16th strong wind with thick weather at 4 am the
other ship lowered 3 boats at 8 am she hoisted her
sighal for sperm whales got the whales to leeward
double reefed and lowered 3 boats the starboard
boat had a good chance but the dumberd night
did not recover his iron with force enough to get on
to tagix green lookbores whale took off to leeward
and then one riding and lost sight of them
came on board thick and stormy this end this
day Buckle client went to see by here

Sept 18th Com^d with one heavy squalls with rain
Monday) ship heading on at 4 pm more ship the best
17th weather in light-mid strong breeze at
daylight breaking out for water and to cooper
flour two end ships in sight

Sept 19th Com^d with light airs and heavy swell engaged in
Tuesday) steering of storm halckney at 4 pm finished making
18th off 120° at 4 pm ship under short sail heading on
and light airs at daylight made all sail at sail
and the land in sight this end

Sept 20th Com^d with light airs ship heading on at 6 pm
Wednesday) ship heading of northward too sperm and
19th calm at daylight made all sail heading to the
westward at 8 am one ship off shore so end

Cruising Of Quase

Sept 21st Com^d with strong breeze at 6 pm ship heading on
Thursday) at 7 pm saw several whales and 1 mile distant
20th to a whale did not see any fore whales close made
heading to the westward later thick weather plenty preserved
in the light ship steering off shore so end

Sept 22nd Com^d with thick foggy weather one ship in sight
Friday) at 5 pm ship heading on 14 months 16 at 5 pm
21st and thick foggy weather ship heading on under
double reefed at 6 am saw a school of black fish
lowered for them with out success later steering
210° getting out previous so end

Sept 23rd Com^d with thick foggy weather at 4 pm saw
Saturday) the land supposed Quase more ship off shore
22nd January and fine rain heavy weather closed reefed
later more moderate made sail cover m.e. so end

Sept 24th Com^d with strong wind from on at 4 pm saw the
Sunday) side of Quase more ship off shore heading on at 7 pm
23rd wind increasing closed reefed and sent down
the Tonal yard and blowing heavy with rain
the running at 1 am more ship set reefed fore and
at 4 am saw the land 12 miles ahead and
one reef set fore and whole fore and this end 4 sails in sight

Sept 25th Com^d with gale abating ship heading west wind on
Monday) 6 sails in sight heading to west and heavy swell
24th and more more white later 4 sails in sight
wind increasing sent down 4 sails to repair so end
