Scmt^{rs} Saturday March 6th
Calm with fine weather this day sent one watch
on shore Mr Dwyer came on board and also re-
turned

Scmt^{rs} Sunday March 7th
Calm with fine weather one watch on shore
this day James O'Brien Anton Sylvia Sylvester
Jo Sylvia John Boatstower and William Connors
deserted this End

Scmt^{rs} Monday March 8th
Calm with getting up all sent six balls on board
the Decadeas this day caught some of the reman-
ants put them in the calabash this End

Scmt^{rs} Tuesday March 9th
Calm with fine weather getting off water piece of
hired from the shore at 4 pm sent one rest on
shore this day coast deserted belonging to the place

Scmt^{rs} Wednesday March 10th
Calm with fine weather got off one rest of water
Employ in stowing it through the day this End

Scmt^{rs} Thursday March 11th
Calm with fine weather sent part of the
men on liberty the other working in water this End

Scmt^{rs} Friday March 12th
Calm with painting sent in part of the men
on liberty at 3 pm finished painting and cleared
up Deck and calms this End

Sailing in Salcahuano

Scmt^{rs} Saturday March 13th
Calm with thick weather nothing going on this
day at 9 am sent in a boat one man also called
George Webster by name this End

Scmt^{rs} Sunday March 14th
Calm with thick weather wind from the north
this day gave the cooper up as missing this End

Scmt^{rs} Monday March 15th
Calm with thick weather wind from the north
Ship ready for sea meeting ship then shipped 5 men
and one boatstower this day this End

Scmt^{rs} Tuesday March 16th
Calm with thick foggy weather Employ in various jobs

Scmt^{rs} Wednesday March 17th
Calm with clear weather Employ in painting the boats
at 4 pm finished this day three Spaniards came
on board shipped for one year this End

Scmt^{rs} Thursday March 18th
Calm with leaving short wind veered to the north came
to again this day last two men stole a boat and paddled
ashore got the boat again at 7 pm heard nothing from
the remanants 3 Spaniards and one English boatstower
came on board James Earl O'Brien peace Deserted
this End

Scmt^{rs} Friday March 19th
Calm with heavy wind with rain shipped a cork one man came
on board at 6 pm sent boat on shore at 6 1/2 pm returned
with 4 remanants Genoa trip Wilcox Connors Kite Shes
and then stuck out shore chain mind to light but has
died for the night all hands on board
