TCM's am with gale breaking up ship heading in 2n under
Wednesday closed reef nine 22 m and calms later the same
March 3th one watch making dinner this end

TCM's am with light air from the south ship heading
Thursday East the two islands in sight at 6 pm both
April 1st in light sails and single reefed and steering
breeze at daylight seven in sight made all sail steering
E or E sent down a spar to spare this end
Left 22.51 78.06

TCM's am with fine pleasant weather ship steering
Friday E or E at 2 pm hauled main sail and bent it
April 2nd at 6 pm the ship for the night and
strong wind ship the wind at 6 am ran beach
proved to be fine back one sail in sight this end

TCM's am with strong winds from south very rough
Saturday closed reef furled fore and main course ship
April 3rd heading East ship light gale at 7 am kept off
S & E reefed ship heavy sea carried away potato
Pen luffed to the wind under short sail & E
Left 22.01 77.59

TCM's am with a gale from the south at 4 pm kept off
Sunday S & E ship taking in and under the water state in
April 4th going away loaded small shore shore water
at 7 am down pinback's made sail steering
S & E thus end thick weather heavy swell

TCM's am with light breeze from south with a
Monday heavy swell and thick weather course E or E
April 5th all sail set ship light breeze at 10 am
used to the work ship heading S & E later getting
out Provision the main line in sight & E
Left 20.47

TCM's am with light air and thick weather at 2 pm
Tuesday near ship of shore and dist 10 miles nothing in
April 6th light sail calms later found dist 12 miles one
watch rigging davits for spar boat this end
Left 20.41 78.40

TCM's am with light air from the south ship course
Wednesday S or E along shore nothing in sight Tonga Bay
April 7th dist 26 miles intend to haul a right whale
from there in the morning sail calms at 10 am
calm land dist 27 miles covered 3 boats and pole
in shore at Meriden got in to the land got dinner
this end tongue bay dist 15 miles to land

TCM's am with light air from the south set sails
Thursday and put down along shore at 11 pm got into
April 8th the bay at 4 pm got up to the head of the
bay saw nothing at 4 E got out and came
in board kept off 10 am and light air
later strong breeze came on this end hooked 4 cods

TCM's am with strong whole sail breeze from south cure
Friday 8 am one sail in sight ship fresh breeze better
April 9th smatch the same one sail in sight one watch
making spinnaker and to work in the rigging

TCM's am with strong breeze from SSW - cure a.v.
Saturday at 5 pm hauled up mast single reefed main
April 10th Trepid sail shore water later down one sail & E

TCM's am with light air course south at 6 pm spunk
Sunday ship anchor and galenda and light air at daylight
April 11th made all sail heading in 2n galenda in sight
thus end with catching a prospect
