Stetm's crew with whole sail breez at 1 pm kept off west at  
Monday 4 pm luffed to the wind took in light sail at 6 pm single  
April 15th reefed fore mainsail more ship heading 338 me sail in  
light mid strong wind doubled reefed took in jib  
latter more moderate trade sail down foreback's lee chug  
at Meridian more ship heading 338 this end.  
Lett 35.26 75.44

Stetm's crew with strong trades ship heading 338 by the wind at  
Tuesday 4 pm one sail in sight at 6 pm took in main chug  
April 16th moderate breeze at daylight made all sail more  
ship to the eastward at 10 am more ship to 3 on foreback's  
in sight one watch setting up fore top gallant rigging to 3  
Lett 35.26 75.44

Stetm's crew with light airs and clear weather at 4 pm  
Wednesday put out starboard boom boat at 6 pm more ship  
April 17th heading east mid light airs later calm employed in  
setting up main top gallant rigging this end

Stetm's crew with light airs at 2 pm 3 on blackfish  
Thursday lined 2 boats starboard boat struck 4 and got  
April 18th saved the 4 got the stowen boat along side. Water  
boat got 2 along side main boat struck one  
and lost him at 4 pm got them in and began  
to clean them at 10 pm finished at daylight  
began to get ready to sail at 2 am took in  
stowen boat to repair later sailing and repairing  
stowen boat setting in sight 3 on

Stetm's crew with calm captain and carpenter repairing  
Friday stowen boat at 6 pm finished caulking this end  
April 19th later some employed in repairing stowen boat  
this end  
Lett 35.50 76.00

April 21st

Stetm's crew with calm nothing in sight at 8 pm light  
Monday rain mid strong breeze from 338 ship heading 3 on  
April 22nd the other ship in sight later the same 3 on  
Lett 35.50 76.15

Stetm's crew with strong breeze and heavy swell ship heading  
Tuesday 3 on at 4 pm put out starboard boat at 6 pm  
April 23rd shortened sail for the night mid strong winds  
took in foresail later the same rigged this end  
Lett 36.14 76.15

Stetm's crew with strong winds ship under double reef  
Wednesday heading 3 on the archer in sight at 5 pm more ship  
April 24th heading to the eastward at 9 pm more ship heading 3 on  
later moderate breaking out 12 sails 3 on

Stetm's crew with moderate weather employed in repairing  
Thursday jib at 4 pm bent it mid light airs later  
April 25th port employed in repairing foresail at Meridian  
finished it

Stetm's crew with light airs repairing maintetree at 4 pm bent  
Friday fore sail the island of St Felix in sight bearing 3 on  
April 26th at 5 pm more ship heading 3 on mid fine weather later  
port repairing fore top sail the island in sight 3 on
