 April 24th) Wind strong breeze latter the same all rest set
 ship heading E by S this end
 Lett

Steamer came with whole sail breeze ship heading E at 8 pm near
 Sunday) Ship to 8 m took in light sails and later light
 April 25th) rains sun one pinback the end ship ready to
 Lett 26.21 26.45

Steamer came with whole sail breeze thick weather
 Monday) Ship heading to the eastward at 6 pm took in light
 April 26th) sails and main course and light breeze later calm
 nothing in sight this end

Steamer came with calm nothing in sight mid calm
 Tuesday) Part Porpoises in sight Employed in painting jibboom
 April 27th) Bay at most heads on top jellat heads to end

Steamer came with calm nothing in sight mid calm
 Wednesday) daylight calm a merchant brig in sight latter
 April 28th) part Employed in painting lower masts to end

Steamer came with light airs sun a Purpleback going quick
 Thursday) at 8 pm finished lower masts at 6 pm took in light
 April 29th) sails at 2 pm kept off for the 20 ground no whels here
 mid and latter light airs this end

Steamer came with fresh trades at 2 pm sun breeches supposed them
 Friday) to be humpbacks however for them they was pinbacks
 April 30th) came on board made sail steary N.E. at 6 pm
 took in light sails and signals at daylight observed
 all sail one sail in sight later observed to end
 Lett 28.00

Down the Coast of Peru

Steamer came with light wind course N.E. at 4 pm took in light sails
 May 1st) kept off north mid light air at daylight made all sail
 (1851) saw killers Porpoises emerald finbacks at 11 am saw
 particles of a wreck picked several dead egs piece of main
 rail one cabin clew several small articles there land in sight
 Lett 21.32

Steamer came with light airs and smoky weather at 2 pm
 May 2nd) packed up a cask of fresh water and a topmast
 second) stunning sail beam at 6 pm took in light sails
 at 1 am hauled by the wind off shore at 6 am made
 all sail steering N.E. later some land in sight to end
 Lett 21.02 21.32

Steamer came with light airs course N.E. in land dist 20 miles
 May 3rd) at 8 pm took in light sails steering N.W. by N mid
 third) light airs course N.E. later course N.W. in sight this end
 thick smoky weather

Steamer came with light airs nothing in sight at 8 pm took
 May 4th) in light sails course N.E. in mid calm later the
 Tuesday 5th) some Employed in filling a stanchion to the wheel
 this end smoky weather

May 5th) came with calm smoky weather nothing in sight
 Wednesday) mid calm at daylight light breeze from N.W.
 May 6th) ship heading on same pinbacks again Porpoises short
 sunfish skip jacks this end
 Lett 19.00

Steamer came with light airs ship heading to the eastward
 Thursday) nothing in sight mid calm latter one brig in sight
 May 6th) this end

Steamer came with calm headed brig Joseph Francois of Valparaiso
 Friday) bound to Peru mid and later light airs nothing
 Friday 7 in daylight Lett 19.38
