 other along side and got supper ship heading 88
 (October 22nd) getting for cutting at 6 am heave on
 at 9 am got in two and heave on the head of the
 other empty & in cutting up blubber this 2nd

(11th 11th) com' with cutting in the body at 1 pm got it in and
 (Friday) began to clear away heave at 6 pm worked off at
 (October 23rd) started the work ship heading to the 3rd and
 and with light air empty in boiling the 2nd

(11th 11th) com' with fine weather still boiling ship heading
 (Saturday) to the 2nd & all went set 3rd strong trade at
 (October 24th) 2 in more ship heading on 88 at Meridian finished

 (Sunday) 9 pm tacked ship heading 88 at 2 am tacked

 (Wednesday) ground tree on the Galapagos side of
 (October 27th) the main sheet away at 5 pm took up
 one cork found it rotten and one cork sheet
 states broke at 6 pm Charles island in sight 1/2 N
 so sails bearing on ship heading 3 pm closed heave
 light sails in strict part flying off shore
 black at 7 am took out 2 green and two corks
 found them good two conclude this 2nd

(11th 11th) com' with stormy down at 2 pm finished all
 (Thursday) and began to stem off the hold at 6 pm finished on
 (October 28th) worked off the deck at 7 pm took in light sails
 heading to the south Charles island in sight bearing 1/2 N
 strict light air like some blackish porpoises
 and finbacks in sight found really the 2nd

(11th 11th) com' with fine weather at 2 pm saw a humpback whale
 (Friday) going to windward toward 2 boats without success
 (October 29th) at 4 pm Charles island in sight strict part flying off
 little part running off plenty of finbacks in sight
 this 2nd South Head dist 1 mile one sail in sight

(11th 11th) com' with light air at 2 pm strong breeze took
 (Saturday) in light sails at 5 1/2 pm spoke Marques catchelot
 (October 30th) one week from Santa Clara strict part flying
 black at daylight steering 1/2 N per North Head
 like the same at Meridian with head dist 6
 miles catchelot in sight this 2nd
