STEWARD (a.c.) with strong trade sent in one boat to collect... Saturday 13th to find anchorage found none safe came in lower... December) and departed at 7 pm went in again brought off... of large turtle and great leaping in the sound... at daylight kept off for James Island Harbor at 2 am... came to anchor in 9 fathoms water sent 18 men on shore... for terosin this day

STEWARD (a.c.) with men coming down with no terosin... Sunday) at 5 pm making preparations to try on the spaining... November 14th) the other side of the island at 6 am started with... 11 men on a single good chase this day

STEWARD (a.c.) with turpin at 3 pm returned with a turpin... Monday) turpin to forge to back of hills gave it up in... December 15th) the turpin going after wood at daylight sent... in two boats for wood at Spaurdin returned this

STEWARD (a.c.) with strong trade at 2 pm got under way... Tuesday) at 5 pm got in char Stomed at 6 pm hauled... December 16th) to the wind under two topsails and gill... at daylight made sail steering in English... in painting Seaboard boat one sail in sight this

STEWARD (a.c.) with strong trade and smoky weather at 5 pm... Wednesday) saw two ships to the north along side saw... November 17th) hauled for them proved to be finbacks did not... see the whales came on lower shortened sail... and strong trade single reefed at daylight saw... breaches proved to be finbacks like some in the... left 54 1/2

STEWARD (a.c.) with blinding weather boat ship heading... Thursday) to the Eastward plenty of finbacks in sight... December 18th) and later moderate English in repairing... fire to sail north head and oblong in sight... this day

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STEWARD (a.c.) with fine weather nothing in sight... Monday) but finbacks at 4 pm sent fire to sail and later... November 19th) along the Peak of Dunda in sight this day... left

STEWARD (a.c.) with light airs and calm 3 sails in sight on... Tuesday) the Peak and calm later light air came on... nothing in sight but one sail

STEWARD (a.c.) with light airs came on at 5 pm spoke beyond... Sunday) Edward of New Bedford and strong breeze ship... November 21st) heading E by S at 7 am kept of N E at 9 am saw... finbacks plenty at Meridian saw breaches this day

STEWARD (a.c.) with light airs at 2 pm saw a shoal of sperm... Monday) whales came and calm hauled 3 boats west... November 22nd) boat struck line parted whales took off... on the wind to the westward gave chase... at dusk gave them up could not get at 7 1/2 pm... were in lower and calm later same this day

STEWARD (a.c.) with calm and light airs one sail in sight... Tuesday) and oblong to island and light air ship heading... to the N E later nothing in sight this day

STEWARD (a.c.) with fine clear weather finbacks in sight... Wednesday) at 5 pm more ship to the westward all sail set... November 24th) and the same at 7 am saw breaches proved... to be nothing later heavy attendance in sight

STEWARD (a.c.) with light air one ship in sight looking... Thursday) and calm later strong breeze ship heading to... 25th) the westward oblong and north head in... sight this day
