Sept 11th) Com' with light airs whole going quick 14 boats chasing
Westward at 6 pm all gave them up no ship yet anything
December 2nd) hard times all that was wanting was a little wind
Mid and latter light airs 4 sails in sight this Eas

Nov 11th) Com' with light airs 4 sails in sight at night spoke
Thursday) barque Seapattet Mid light airs later light breeze
December 22d) 3 sails in sight and abington island this Eas getting out half

Friday) Com' with calm and light airs abington island distant
December 24) 12 miles to windward strong current running
to windward Mid calm later light breeze
4 sails in sight this Eas

December 25th) Com' with calm Mid the same later light breeze
Dec 26th) 5 ships in sight nothing else this Eas

December 26th) Com' with light airs 4 sails in sight Mid calm
Sun 26th) later strong breeze ship heading to the Eastward 3 sails

December 27th) Com' with strong trade ship heading to the Eastward
Monday) at 6 pm took in light sails Middle and
December 28th) later strong breeze 3 ships in sight this Eas

December 29th) Com' with strong whole sail breeze ship heading
Tuesday) to the Eastward Mid light airs at 9 am
December 30th) took ship heading Eas this Eas
lett 114 51

January 1st) Com' with moderate breeze ship heading Eas
Wednesday) all sail set Mid and later strong breeze
December 29) nothing in sight this Eas

Sept 11th) Com' with light trades at 8 pm saw towers
Thursday) island bearing N.W. at 6 pm took ship
December 20th) to the Eastward at 2 am took ship
at 6 am towers island 2 points off the horn kept
off sent in 2 boats fishing this Eas strong current

Dec 21st) Com' with light airs at 5 pm boat returned with
Friday) 200 codfish at 5 pm got them under salt
December 31st) Mid part ship heading to the Eastward later
the same nothing in sight this Eas

January 1st) Com' with strong wind ship heading to the Eastward
Saturday) Mid and later the same one sail in sight
January 2nd) heading to the westward this Eas

January 3rd) Com' with strong trade ship heading E & S Mid
January 4th) and later ship heading to the Eas this Eas

January 5th) Com' with light trades at 7 pm spoke ship & contacted
Monday) Middle and later strong breeze ship heading to the
January 6th) Eastward nothing in sight but sails

January 7th) Com' with strong trade nothing in sight Middle
Tuesday) and later the same one match empty tarring
January 8th) nothing in sight

January 9th) Com' with light airs better action in sight ship heading
January 10th) to Eastward at 9 pm more to the westward
Mid and later light airs this Eas

January 11th) Com' with light airs one sail in sight ship heading
January 12th) to the westward one sail in sight this Eas
