Steamer) and with fine breeze ship heading 300 at 2 pm beat
 Saturday) fore and aft light air latter part breezing out - green
 January 22) on the starboard side of shifting fresh water in other casks

Steamer) and with light air at 2 pm finished and steamed off
 Sunday) ship heading 300 by the wind and light air
 January 23) nothing in sight one watch empty variously in the
 Lat 1.10 2

Steamer) and with light breeze ship 300 nothing in sight and
 Monday) and light air at daylight began to break out after dark
 January 24) starboard side found one cask with 4 broken staves in
 the lower bilge and another with two the two pumps water

Steamer) and with light air at 4 pm finished steamed off ship
 Tuesday) heading 300 wind calm like dawn blackfish lines steamed
 January 25) and dramed thus end
 Lat 9 miles 20 Long 103.39

Steamer) and with light air and heavy swell at 1 pm saw
 January 26) a shoal of sperm whales several whales very thin
 Wednesday) a large shoal of blackfish got in amongst them
 and killed them so could not get the boats anywhere
 near them whales took to mind most going like the same
 and one light air strong current running to the north this

Steamer) and with calm and light air and the same latter
 Thursday) employed in taking out pumps pumps ducts with
 9 inches water above the skin thus end

Steamer) and with light air employed with the pumps at 2 pm saw black
 Friday) line and beat got one at 2 pm got pumps in all right
 January 28) and light air and strong current running to the south
 employed in steaming blackfish thus end
 Lat 2 miles 20 Long 103.00

Round towards the Marquesas Islands

Steamer) and with fine breeze ship heading 80 at night beat
 Saturday) in light air and strong breeze later shoreward
 January 29) employed in breaking out for space for nothing in sight

Steamer) and with light breeze this day beat near the
 Sunday) other one seen at night took in light air
 January 30) ship heading 80 and light air like being met the
 Lat 38 miles 3 Long 53

Steamer) and with light air at 6 pm took in light air
 Monday) course in mid air light air Peter leading blackfish
 thus end one fishback in sight
 Lat 44 miles 3 Long 107.40

Steamer) and with light air and thick weather course in
 Tuesday) at 1 pm sent in fish to repair at 2 pm finished and
 February 1st) beat at mid air light air employed in clearing
 ship from blackfish going quick thus end
 Lat 5 miles 3 Long 108.22

Steamer) and with light air ship heading to the S at 6 pm took in light
 Wednesday) and light off in 300 and light air latter part empty
 February 2nd) beat in breaking out the ground two casks in the after hold
 found two staves broken in each cask thus end

Steamer) and with light air steaming by the wind heading 300
 Thursday) greenhouses and fishbacks in sight and light
 February 3rd) light air and paper in sight thus end

Steamer) and with light air and thick weather ship heading 300
 Friday) by the wind and light part steaming by the wind
 February 4th) light air employed in repairing by night
 Lat 55 miles 3 Long 117.59
