

Log Of Bayne Greyhound Of Westport

Jan 1st (Sun) with light weather and rain wind buffing
 (Monday) 2nd (Tue) still strong breeze at daylight saw the island
 (Tuesday) 3rd (Wed) of Oahu one of the Mergueses bearing
 west at 8 am sent barboard anchor at 9 am
 hauled aboard sent in two boats to trade this day

Jan 4th (Wed) with trading for figgs and bananas coconuts
 (Thursday) 5th (Thurs) still strong off and on at 8 am sent in two boats
 (Friday) 6th (Fri) for trade at Merrick came off with one
 boat load of wood figgs and coconuts this day

Jan 7th (Sun) with trading at 2 pm Captain came on board
 (Monday) 8th (Mon) returned to another bay for trade at 4 pm left boat
 (Tuesday) 9th (Tue) on shore still strong off and on strong wind at 11 am
 sent in two boats for potatoes at Merrick returned
 with 20 bbls this day discharged Charles Wood
 Rootstensen his time up ship for the cruise

Jan 10th (Wed) with unloading boats sent them on shore again
 (Thursday) 11th (Thurs) returned with 11 bbls at 6 pm departed again
 (Friday) 12th (Fri) for Mowheoe steering in light breeze still just
 strong aback off the island at 9 am entered the
 harbor at 11 am came to anchor in 10 fathoms
 water at 2 pm got a raft of a hundred bbls of oil
 on shore cleared ship and took in starboard boat
 to her account

Jan 13th (Sun) with filling water & repairing iron work painting
 (Monday) 14th (Mon) land and freshening out at Merrick finished
 (Tuesday) 15th (Tue) filling a hundred bbls at 4 pm stored off fire hole
 with empty casks and cleared up decks to us

Jan 16th (Wed) with taking off raft of water at 3 pm
 finished making ship and strong water this day

Jan 17th (Thurs) with with rain weather at 10 am clear
 commenced painting at 4 pm finished one side one match
 on shore on Sides at sunset one ship in the offing this day

Jan 18th (Fri) with with painting one match on shore at 10 am
 ship George Washington came in at anchor this day

Jan 19th (Sat) with getting off water and wood
 (Sunday) 20th (Sun) and painting one match on shore this day

Jan 21st (Mon) with fine weather nothing doing one match on shore
 (Tuesday) 22nd (Tue)

Jan 23rd (Wed) with getting off wood and potatoes
 this day discharged Henry Kachire John Kirocku
 Ben Segman their office time up ship for one year

Jan 24th (Thurs) March first (Wed) with painting one match
 on shore at 2 pm taking off potatoes to her rear

Jan 25th (Fri) March second (Thurs) with painting one boat
 crew match on shore this day

Jan 26th (Sat) March third (Fri) with clearing up decks getting
 aboard this day ship John Kachire came to anchor this day
