Prichy March 4th) Delay for Desertion Letter getting ready for sea
Ship Christopher Smith in the offing

2nd M^o 1st) Went with all ready for sea waiting for a wind
but no chance came so far

3rd M^o 1st) Sunday) Went with light airs at 8 am got under way
March 6th) for Type Bay for wood at 2 pm came to anchor
in 22 fathoms water H^o Christopher Smith at anchor

4th M^o 1st) Went with getting off wood and setting up rigging so far
March 7th) at midnight cabin ship seamen Prichy
Pianaca Boatster remaining on shore

5th M^o 1st) Went with getting off wood got off 3 boat loads and
March 7th) Men looking for runaways at night heard from the
March 8th) the end all ready for sea waiting for the two men for us

6th M^o 1st) Went with going on shore before daylight I had to travel eight
March 9th) Went with 200 lbs of rocks and stones to get at them two men
March 10th) at 8 am caught them at 9 am got them on board
beided them up in the rigging and punished them
as they deserved at 10 am streamed out cage and began
working out the ship the other ship the same so far could not

7th M^o 1st) Went with working out at 4 pm got out side of the bay
March 11th) at 4 pm hauled aback off shore because long cast went
March 12th) on shore to settle for the runaways then put
lying off and on like the same

8th M^o 1st) Went with lying off and on at 3 pm Capt
Prichy) came on board made sail for Papea for shore
March 13th) put lying off and on at Papea at 8 am
Capt went on shore to obtain shore at Papea in
returned no shore made all sail for the windward
part of the island to far

Bound Towards Coast Of California

9th M^o 1st) Went with making to windward at 6 pm went
March 14th) in light sails at 9 am captured more
in shore for men so far

10th M^o 1st) Went with captain coming off no men heard
March 15th) to Whylotea Strait and little strong breeze
all sail set working up to windward so far

11th M^o 1st) Went with strong trade all sail set ship heading to the
March 16th) at mid strong breeze letter put the island of Whylotea
March 17th) at 10 miles to windward so far working up

12th M^o 1st) Went with lying off and on this day shifted
March 18th) at 10 am two whites Robert Chen turn escape from ship
March 19th) at 8 am Capt came on board
made sail for Papea for shore then at 8 am
Capt went on shore no men put off for Papea

13th M^o 1st) Went with strong breeze at 8 am Capt went on shore
March 20th) to obtain men at daylight came off with
two Kanakas made all sail steering to the
North this far

14th M^o 1st) Went with strong breeze even 8 am at 6 pm
March 21st) shifted to the wind two islands in sight strong
March 22nd) trades with squalls so far

15th M^o 1st) Went with strong trade ship heading to the
March 23rd) wind at 9 am squally weather but in
March 24th) light sails little rain with heavy squalls
single reefed first time for 5 months
this far
