At present with strong wind at 6 pm hauled to the
 Monday 1) In island dist 10 miles plenty of birds in
 sight at 7 am more ship steering in then the
 disabled vessel steaming under canvas island seen & seen
 S E

At present with strong wind at 7 pm spoke large
 Tuesday 2) Large Warren of San Francisco was visible
 April 3) found in mid just heading to this point at 10 am
 more ship steering west land in sight to E

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At present with light airs ship heading to the S & E
 Wednesday 4) at 6 pm land dist 10 miles the coast more ship
 April 5) shortened sail at 1 pm heading in at 5 pm went
 in to turtle Bay found some get some salt
 and a few chores & E

At present with looking for turtle at 4 pm came out
 Thursday 6) Steady off shore mid part more in at 9 am
 April 7) from Humphreys line for then going to gulch
 could not get on came on board but dist 6 miles
 course 88 E then E

At present with light airs, course 88 E at 6 pm shortened
 Friday 8) sail mid light airs ship heading in later
 April 9) Steady 88 land dist 30 miles & E

At present with light airs a great many finches
 Saturday 10) in sight at 6 pm more ship off shore took in
 April 11) light sails sail light airs little Steady
 finches in sight & E

At present with fine clear weather finches
 Sunday 12) in sight course 88 E at night took in
 May 13) light sails sail Steady breeze 88 in sight
 of 88 under that sail at 10 am spoke large
