

Log of Bayne Greyhound of Westport

Thurs^{day} (Sun) with equally weather at 2 pm rains ship heading
Thurs^{day} 4th at 6 pm took in light sails and strong breeze
fine 5th at daylight a merchant ship in sight heading to the east
before they keep ship heading 8 & the wind 5 & 6

Thurs^{day} Friday July 2nd 1884

Com^{mander} with strong winds and head sea nothing
in sight ship just steady breeze later the same
took on her boat and put her also head this day
took out all the heavy soap out of the cask getting
ready for cooping oil & 4th
lat 2.37 lon 27.07

Thurs^{day} (Sun) with fine clear weather ship heading 8 & 9
Thurs^{day} 4th of the wind and moderate at daylight in
July 5th (Sun) a sail to land nothing in sight

lat 2.00 lon 25.24

Thurs^{day} (Sun) with moderate weather at 4 pm
Sun^{day} 5th spoke began to grope and little
July 6th (Sun) put steady breeze ship heading 8 & 9
lat 2.34 lon 25

Thurs^{day} (Sun) with strong winds the Logrange in sight
Thurs^{day} 4th (Sun) put steady breeze at 4 pm shortened sail
July 5th (Sun) breaking out to coope oil at 10 am got
all cut on Starboard side and commenced
cooping found 9 inches water standing on the
skin pumps would not draw it hurried it
cut in strap tubes took up Limber board
found gully ahead had cleared out between
the timbers still the pumps would not take the
water pumps are set to run to suck the water
off the skin to end with lifting up water

On the Equator Gasping Oil

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Thurs^{day} (Sun) with fine weather at 1 pm began to steer
Starboard found one large green tier cask and 2 rotten
July 5th (Sun) and one broken steam at 6 pm finished steering
off Starboard side at daylight commenced
on Starboard side at 10 am got all up and
began to clean up gully & 4th lat 1.17

Thurs^{day} (Sun) with strong down at 5 pm got down to casks
Thurs^{day} 4th in good order found several casks with broken steams
July 5th (Sun) having to smelt weight on top of them
Ship put steady all sail at daylight began to steer
down at Starboard finishes from Starboard & 9
no observations

Thurs^{day} (Sun) with fine weather began to break out for
Thurs^{day} 4th found one cask all leaked out and two
July 5th (Sun) ground casks all rotten at 6 pm spoke began
Domingo 8 months out 40 lbs and rising little
Pinckney of strong rising weather to land

Thurs^{day} (Sun) with thick weather finished Starboard side
Friday 6th found one cask nearly all out & rotten steams
July 5th (Sun) at 2 pm got all up in Starboard side found one
rotten all cask and the fresh water casks in the
ground had fresh water in 12 months at 5 pm
got down to ground casks and tied up. spoke
Domingo in right weather suddenly middle the same
little put finish in the fore hold and began in the
after hold & 4th
