 Wednesday) over casks at 5 pm more ship to the westward
 July 13th) and the same late to work on casks

Sept 1st) Am with steady wind off Dicks at 1 pm more
 Thursday) ship heading to the west from humpbacks at 6 pm
 July 14th) finished repairing the last cask and i am glad
 i am tired of cooping get no coops and heart
 had the last 10 months and light air late
 heading in three humpbacks going quick and

Sept 1st) Am with heading in three all red set at 4 pm
 Friday) saw humpbacks going quick in three about
 July 15th) strong breeze & daylight saw the line at 10 am
 to head ship off line at Merriam's feet off 8

Sept 1st) Am with strong breeze ship running along the
 Saturday 16th) looking for a place to anchor two humpbacks
 at 6 pm headed to the wind off the line at 8 am
 came to anchor in 5 fathoms of water 3 spots
 Pchona Monterey lined the boats went in
 three ran no humpbacks came on board
 took anchor to work to windward in 6

Sept 1st) Am with strong breeze heading up in the
 Sunday 17th) large William Lee in sight and put beating up

 Monday) lined & look Starboard boat struck a large
