Sept 1st (Sun) with strong breeze at Meriden point
 Tuesday) and got under way and bent up to Secamus
 September 2nd) at 3 pm came to anchor in 8 fathoms water 200

Sept 3rd (Mon) with taking off horses no Palatoes here
 Wednesday) at noon strong trade 300
 September 4th)

Sept 5th (Tue) with mauling at 6 pm when came off had
 Thursday) cut 5 boat loads 300
 September 6th)

Sept 7th (Wed) with getting off off wood at 2 pm got off
 Friday) 5 boat loads employed in cutting it up 300
 Friday Sept 9th)

Sept 10th (Sat) with leaving ship and taking station at anchor
 Saturday) on the horn at 2 am got under way 300
 September 10th) up to Secamus to end civic time

Sept 11th (Sun) with cutting up wood heading off shore
 Sunday) baggage in company having obtained 100 400
 September 11th) a piece of whale oil at 4 pm to take off shore
 at 8 to take in wind and little heading off shore
 nothing in sight

Sept 12th (Mon) with strong breeze at 2 pm to take ship heading
 Monday) in shore at 4 am heading off shore at 7 to take in
 September 12th) baggage in sight and the Secamus 300

Leaving At Anchor In Secamus

Sept 13th (Tue) with light trade heading in shore at 6 pm
 Tuesday) take off the sand bar one mile at 9 pm
 September 13th) takes in shore at 11 to take off the reef
 at 8 am take in from the sand

Sept 14th (Wed) with strong trade went off ship to repair
 Wednesday) bent over one inch of off to cut up
 September 14th) to repair off ship bent over 1 inch of off to cut up
 to take off the sand bar 2 miles this off the Secamus 300

Sept 15th (Thu) with light trade baggage in sight on the side of Flat
 Thursday) and put heading of the Secamus fast clearing ship heading in shore

Sept 16th (Fri) with light trade and heavy swell bent down
 Friday) five tons of rail to repair at 2 pm bent it 3 inches
 September 16th) off shore at daylight to take in the Secamus 300

Sept 17th (Sat) with light air heading in at 6 pm got on shore off the
 Saturday) Secamus bent over 2 miles at daylight Secamus 300
 September 17th) at 8 am came to anchor in Secamus 300 getting
 cargo ready for water

Sept 18th (Sun) with strong breeze at 2 pm to take ship heading
 Sunday) baggage in company having obtained 100 400
 September 18th) a piece of whale oil at 4 pm to take off shore
 at 8 to take in wind and little heading off shore
 nothing in sight

Sept 19th (Mon) with fine weather bent, rest on the Secamus
 Monday) and get it off in one tide baggage in company
 September 19th) bent water 300
