 (Sunday) whales coming to lower end toward then
 (January 21st) boat at 4 1/2 pm Scurbeard boat struck
 a small calf whale they got the whale brought
 to long enough for meat but to strike the can
 got about of Scurbeard boats line by dem palishus
 had to cut his line took a poor splice in it
 whale spouting good blood killed with the iron
 took to sounding at 6 pm and the splice
 chained and away went the whale to hell
 down a tirlin for a boat headed whale ought
 to have been saved and no mistake at 6 pm
 got all to the ship began to hoist him in
 whale to heavy let him remain all night
 made sail working to mind more at 8 am
 hoisted on at 7 got him in now ship made
 all sail at 8 am some whales going quick
 to General Blackfish and purpises got in
 amongst them one drove them to mind more
 came on board made all sail working to
 mind more whales still in sight to her
 clearing up Decks
