Dec 11th) Com' with strong trade at 4 pm finishes cooping
Wednesday) at 7 pm Captain went on board ship higher
Thursday first) to obtain some water better the same
I care feel here and niger in sight so has

Dec 11th) Com' with strong trade at 2 pm talked ship off the
Thursday) Capt went on board ship niger with two birds
Thursday second) for water began taken it on board 2 cups
at a time got 8 cups 29 lbs of fresh water had
it given as brought the cups at 1 dollar per barrel
Bird part heading in shore strong trade at daylight
Saturday sail were ship and began to stem down
found 4 rotten cups and one 8 barrel cup of oil
nearly all soaked out so has strong down

Left 15. 12 1910

Dec 11th) Com' with rugged weather at 4 pm finishes
Friday) running all the oil down and began to break
Saturday third) Bird for the cups that had broke out 5 cups
of oil to wait to get it it knocked off for
the night at daylight began to break out at dawn
got all on deck at 12 finishes steering off
Ship heading off shore 2 birds in sight so has
