Sept 11th) Can't with whale sail breeze from S. by E. 4 miles
 Sunday) at 6 pm left off S. by E. for Guanfernandes Strait
 March 1st) Part light air and heavy swell. Nothing in sight
 at 11 am San Guanfernandes bearing ENE 30 miles
 light air from the South

Lat 33.50

Sept 11th) Can't with light air steering for the island
 Friday) at 3 pm 35 miles nothing in sight but pursuing
 March 2nd) Wind part lying aback off the port side
 of Quetz at daylight left off for the harbor
 on the East side Employed in getting 2000
 ready for water at 8 am light baffling wind
 left went on shore could not get in with the
 ship to land cargo on shore at 5 pm one boat
 fishing so far

Sept 11th) Can't with squally weather at 5 pm boat returned
 Sunday) Ship lying off and on for the night wind south
 March 3rd) at 5 am sent in the ark for water so far

Sept 11th) Can't with fine weather at 3 pm got off water
 Sunday) one boat returned for fish at 6 pm returning with
 March 4th) all day made all sail bound for Valparaiso
 later they were from the coast ESE 5 miles

Lat 34.07

Sept 11th) Can't with squally weather doubled reefed
 Monday) at 4 pm more squally made some sail
 March 5th) Light breeze employed in hoisting lower masts
 and getting out bread & so on at 8 pm in boat

Lat 33.41 34.20

Sept 11th) Can't with light breeze across ESE wind & one watch
 Sunday) Employed merrily with light breeze at 5 am San
 March 6th) a large whale going quench to windward lined
 2 quarter boats could not get on either boat
 on board more whales coming to windward
 get dinner & so on
