

Log of the Sloop Greystone of Westport

Sept 11th) Calm & gale abating at 2 pm set Main sail
 (Saturday) at 6 pm was off in Sea set Jib and started
 March 10th) the north wind port heavy weather still sailing
 20 species at a time cant keep all in the boat
 later more moderate shade same sail still
 heading in shore ESE & E

Sept 22 40 N. 31

Sept 11th) Calm with fine weather Sea going down quick
 Sunday) still heading in shore still sailing later calm
 March 11th) one thick fog & was with sailing by West
 tumbling down land in sight at intervals
 & E

Sept 11th) Calm with foggy weather at 1 pm finished
 (Monday) sailing and began to clear up at 5 pm bent
 March 12th) chains and more sail off shore lying under short
 sail and the same at 8 am land in sight
 dist 15 miles got anchor off the bars at 10 am
 heading in for the Harbore of Valparaiso
 light in sight in making off Dock

Sept 11th) Calm with light breeze at 11 pm came
 (Tuesday) to anchor in 22 fathoms water in the
 March 13th) Harbore of Valparaiso with 60 fathoms
 chain & was still calm & sea account

Sept 11th) Calm with fine weather getting ready to break out
 (Wednesday) all this day discharged a sick Portuguese
 been in the ship all the voyage at 4 pm took
 out some hempstaple will

Sept 11th) Calm with fine weather rafting all and breaking
 (Thursday) out all at Mercurio took it on shore
 1 part of it now began to stem down the last suble
 at 6 pm got down 16 bbls clear up the Dock
 ready to go in the Dry Dock & E
