Stamps' Com' with Shipping men & men, came on board this
Tues. day at noon strong wind same ship, dragging
April third to end Midnight - Calm

Stamps' Com' with cables 2 men came off this morning
Wednesday at night all the men shipped on board Exacting
April 4th to end

Stamps' Com' with cables Employed in getting ready for sea
April 5th at 2 pm sprung up fresh breeze ship dragged her
anchor the other on the horn to Dutch water
for the light chain made sail and stowed out to sea
under double reef at 5 pm stood in again let
go anchor in 40 fathoms water chain not long enough
to hold her blowing strong hove up again and stowed
out to sea at 8 pm got decks clear of ship
under double reef blowing strong till the dawn
split sail at 7 am stood in for the harbor
Captain came on board all hands Employed in
Securing anchors and bending Jibs at 11 am finished
and washed off Decks to end
