 May 23rd } island and birchlocks at 2 am strong breeze ship heading
 1866 } by the wind S & S West head in sight and abiding ten
 island to windward thus end picking over rotten potatoes
 Salt 47 in 47

Thursday } Comm' with light breeze at 3 pm calm at 6 pm more
 May 24th } ship heading to the S in light air this calm latter
 1866 } part much the same nothing in sight
 Salt 24 in 27

Friday } Comm' with light air at 4 pm more ship heading S
 May 25th } this calm latter light air one sail in sight and menhaden in
 1866 } thus end
 Salt 11 in 57

Saturday } Comm' light air and calm at 6 pm spoke Bark-Ohio
 May 26th } of menhaden & a whole small calm latter fine breeze
 1866 } ship heading S & S North head out 50 miles & sails in sight
 Salt 47 in 57

Sunday } Comm' with light air ship heading S & 2 sails in sight
 May 27th } this calm at daylight the bark out 12 miles and 5 sails in
 1866 } sight thus end with calm

Monday } Comm' with calm & sails in sight this light air
 May 28th } at daylight south head out 10 miles & sails in sight
 1866 } course & nothing in sight thus end

Tuesday } Comm' with light air at 6 pm spoke Bark-Ohio
 May 29th } this calm and light air course S latter part fine
 1866 } breeze ship heading up for South head & sails in sight

Wednesday } Comm' with fine breeze ship heading in for South head
 May 30th } at 3 pm more ship off shore at 9 pm more ship in
 1866 } show light breeze at 12 noon ship off shore at daylight more
 ship in the rainy weather latter part the land in sight South head
 Salt 137 in 1

Thursday } Comm' with light air and bogg weather one sail in
 May 31st } light South head in sight & 80s off the land this light
 1866 } air with rain latter the same spoke Bark-Ohio of menhaden
 thus end with thick weather nothing in sight

Friday } Comm' with light breeze with drizzle rain at interval
 June 1st } ship heading to the Eastward this calm latter the same
 1866 } nothing in sight thick weather

Saturday } Comm' with thick weather at 5 pm spoke ship Elizabeth
 June 2nd } of Menhaden & 80s out clean this calm latter
 1866 } light breeze head island in sight and one sail thus end

Sunday } Comm' with light breeze and thick weather head island
 June 3rd } out 10 miles ship part heading S latter nothing in sight
 1866 } but land head and Charles island thus end

Monday } Comm' with light air & sails in sight and the bark out
 June 4th } 15 miles yardward island ship light air with strong
 1866 } current running to the Westward latter part ship between
 Charles and Haver island trying to work out thus end

Tuesday } Comm' with light breeze & sails in sight and plenty of
 June 5th } birchlocks ship between Charles and Haver island strong current
 1866 } this calm at daylight the same head drifted in the
 sound through the night at 5 am kept off to towards
 Sandspit island English in stormy proceeding towards this
 end with light breeze the island out 20 miles South head
