Friday August 10th Comm' with thick weather Ship heading in towards weather at 3 pm clear saw 21 finbacks and two shoals of Blackfish going quick toward one boat without success at 5 pm kept off N towards North head at 6 pm took in light sails and at 8 pm hauled off shore under short sail Mid Part lying aback at daylight more ship made sail heading in for bay this End in the bay nothing in sight

Saturday August 11th Comm' with strong breeze Ship in bay at 3 pm heading out of the bay at 6 pm took in sail heading off shore at daylight kept off N for the Rocks at Meridian saw one sail ahead this End nothing in sight

Sunday August 12th Comm' with strong breeze Rock in sight at 4 pm spoke Ship Abnolola from the off shore ground one whale and part lying aback at 2 am made all sail Steaming for N E Cape 4 sails in sight this End

Monday August 13th Comm' with strong breeze at 2 pm passed the Rocks came N N E for Thompsons island Mid Part light breeze latter part fine breeze nothing in sight the Lord

Tuesday August 14th Comm' with light breeze course N E nothing in sight latter part fine breeze latter clear weather nothing in sight this End

Wednesday August 15th Comm' with fine weather course N E nothing in sight Mid Part rain latter part part strong breeze nothing in sight this End getting closer reef of for water

Thursday August 16th Comm' with thick weather course N nothing in sight light rain at intervals Mid clear latter part squally nothing in sight this End

Bornet Towards The Cross Islands

Friday August 17th Comm' with clear weather at intervals at 3 pm saw a paddle afloat and a turtle round it lowered and got them both this light air at 5 am saw Cross island bearing N E 20 miles huffed to the wind aback at 6 am kept off towards it at 8 am heavy rain with light air at 11 am hauled main yard aback heading N E got up chain and bent them this End with rain

Saturday August 18th Comm' with heavy rain and light air Ship heading to the S E at 8 pm the latter Mid strong breeze light breeze at 2 am more ship at daylight saw the land bearing on N N W made all sail for the island at Meridian shot in the harbour wind let go tide took Ship out again this End standing off shore

Sunday August 19th Comm' with rainy weather at 4 pm stood in the harbour wind let go again down three boats and streamer a towline with East anchor and began to haul in thick rainy weather at 8 1/2 pm came at anchor in 14 fathoms water with 35 fathoms water furled sails and got Starboard anchor off the bow Mid fine at 9 am took 70 lbs of cast on shore at 10 am boats Ohio came in at 10 am got off reef this End stormy down and clearing bottom

Monday August 20th Comm' with stormy weather Mid fine no rain at 8 am sent 4 men in to cut wood at same with another raft at 10 am got off raft at 11 am got 2 last load of wood cut waiting for the tide this End

Tuesday August 21st Comm' with getting off wood and stormy weather Mid fine weather at 9 am light rain English in morning Starboard anchor let go put all hands on shore washing from both ships so had fine weather
