Monday 1st Comm with fine clear weather light breeze at 2 pm got under way both ships and stood at to sea by the wind heading S & 22d by the wind at 4 pm finished stowing anchors and chains and latter light breeze saw blackfish going quick the other barque in company thus ends

Tuesday 2nd Comm with fine clear weather at 6 pm saw a school of blackfish and fine clear weather latter the same saw a school of blackfish going to quick to windward ends

Wednesday 3rd Comm with light breeze ship heading S & the other ship in company and strong breeze latter the same saw a bark steering to the westward thus ends with rain

Thursday 4th Comm with rain ship heading S & the other barque in company at 4 pm strong wind took in light sails and courses and strong breeze at 7 am wore ship heading west the other ship in sight thus ends

Friday 5th Comm with strong breeze ship under whole topsails heading to the westward at 4 pm wore ship to the eastward at 6 pm took in courses and strong breeze at 7 am wore ship to the westward then shorted the ship in sight heading to the eastward thus ends

Saturday 6th Comm with strong breeze ship heading in by the wind at 6 pm hauled up courses and singled reefed topsails the strong breeze latter the same ship heading to the eastward

Sunday 7th Comm with fine weather 2 sails in sight at 6 pm August 18th 8th saw bark island and morning star and first strong breeze nothing in sight thus ends

Monday 9th Comm with strong breeze 2 sails in sight August 19th 20th strong breeze latter the same ship heading to the westward at meridian saw a sail thus ends

Tuesday 21st Comm with strong breeze ship heading to the westward at 4 pm saw finbacks at 6 pm saw finbacks at sundown shortened sail heading to the westward latter part strong breeze nothing in sight & ends

Wednesday 22nd Comm with strong breeze ship heading to the westward at 6 pm wore ship steering by the wind hauled up courses ship under two topsails and gill at daylight set courses at 7 am saw finbacks latter part strong breeze nothing in sight thus ends

Thursday 23rd Comm with strong breeze and thick weather ship heading to the eastward under short sail and the same at daylight light breeze made all sail latter nothing in sight thick weather so ends

Friday 24th Comm with light breeze and thick weather course at 6 pm puff on the wind heading to the east took in light sails mid light at daylight made all sail thus ends
