 at daylight made all sail steering S & E at 9 am lowered
 for Blackfish Starboard boat struck and drowed
 get none came on board made all sail so End

Wednesday } Comm' with fine weather nothing in sight Course
September 19th } S & E Land Supposed dist 70 miles at 2 pm
Tuesday } Took in fish oil at daylight Saw the land ahead
 dist 12 miles at 7 am wore ship off shore and sent
 down fore sail to repair this End

Thursday } Comm' with thick weather ship heading off shore
September 20th } all sail set nothing in sight and strong breeze
Wednesday } took in light sails latter strong breeze nothing
 in sight ship heading on this End

Thursday } Comm' with strong breeze at 4 pm saw Porpoises
September 21st } at 6 pm left off 8 m at 7 am saw a sail at
 11 pm spoke fork Nautilus sailing this End

Friday } Comm' with light breeze ship heading to the westward
September 22nd } at 6 pm saw Blackfish and Port Legay about
 at 8 am made sail heading N & W the other Bark
 in sight this End

Saturday } Comm' with fine weather ship heading to the
September 23rd } westward nothing in sight at 6 pm took in light
 sails hauled up courses and put paying aback
 later steering N & E nothing in sight

Sunday } Comm' with fine weather 2 sails in sight
September 24th } ship heading to the westward at 7 am saw
 2 sails latter nothing in sight fine and clear this End

Monday } Comm' with clear weather ship heading to the westward
September 25th } at 3 pm heading to S & E one sail in sight at 6
 pm took in light sails and courses and strong
 breeze at daylight made all sail heading to the Eastward
 latter put nothing in sight this End

Lat 45 31 N Long 84 00 W

Tuesday } Comm' with strong breeze and thick weather
September 26th } at 1 pm wore ship to the westward with heads
 yards aback light sails in at daylight made all
 sail steering S & W latter put heads wind to the East
 this End one sail in sight

Lat 45 31 N Long 84 00 W

Wednesday } Comm' with thick weather one sail in sight
September 27th } at 6 pm took in light sails and hauled head up
 aback for the night and put steering S & W at 9 am
 left to the wind to the Eastward nothing in sight this End

Lat 2 05 N Long 84 00 W

Thursday } Comm' with strong breeze saw one finback ship heading
September 28th } to the East at 6 pm took in courses and strong breeze
 at 8 am wore ship heading to the westward latter thick weather
 nothing in sight this End

Lat 145 31 N Long 84 00 W

Friday } Comm' with thick weather at 2 pm clear nothing in sight
September 29th } at 6 pm took in courses and strong breeze latter put
 heading to the westward hove up sails in sight this End
