

Log of Barque "Providence" of Westport

Sept 15th Comd with strong breeze ship heading to the westward nothing in sight at 8 pm more ship to the eastward this strong breeze at 10 am rain at 11 am more ship heading to the westward 2 boats in sight hungry this end

Sept 16th Comd with strong breeze at night spoke barque Sacramento of westport 250 miles past strong breeze latter the same ship heading to the eastward at midnight more ship heading to the westward this end

Sept 17th Comd with light breeze nothing in sight but one sail at 6 pm shortened sail at 8 am made all sail heading in 33 latter the same clear weather nothing in sight this end

Sept 18th Comd with fine clear weather ship heading on and south one match repairing sail at 8 pm took in fly jib and gaff topsail and strong breeze later more moderate finished sea topsail this end nothing in sight

Sept 19th Comd with fine clear weather ship heading to the westward nothing in sight at 6 pm more ship heading E S E all sail out mid the same at 8 am sent down fore topsail to repair and bent another latter part repairing sail nothing in sight

Sept 20th Comd with strong breeze ship heading to the east and south one match repairing sail at 8 pm took in fly jib and gaff topsail and strong breeze later more moderate finished sea topsail this end nothing in sight

Sept 21st Comd with fine weather at 8 pm sent fore topsail ship heading to eastward all sail and the same at 9 am more ship heading to the westward nothing in sight second match still sick

Sept 22nd Comd with strong breeze ship heading to the westward Banple in repairing sail finished and last it at 2 pm nothing in sight six men aloft mid put fine weather carrying all sail latter the same 2 ends

Sept 23rd Comd with fine weather ship heading to the westward one finback in sight this day fine weather in 8 latter the same this end

Sept 24th Comd with fine weather ship heading in 8m nothing in sight as usual mid fine at daylight saw towers island dist 17 miles at 8 am left off in 4 m for abington at 11 am saw a sail heading to the east this end

Sept 25th Comd with fine weather at 1 pm hauled the wind for abington at 6 pm dist 15 miles took in light sail jib and covers at daylight shed all sail was ship standing in towards abington nothing in sight this day as usual good winds when their will be 2 ends

Sept 26th Comd with light and course for abington dist 12 miles at 3 pm hauled to the eastward at 6 pm took in light sails at daylight thick weather heading toward abington latter clear nothing in sight but land at midnight took off shore 2 ends

Sept 27th Comd with clear weather ship heading to the east at 8 pm more ship took in light sails and main course land dist 25 miles mid strong breeze at daylight began to hoist water in Deck at 9 am made all sail more ship heading in towards abington island and finback in sight this end
