

Log of the Brigantine of Baffin

Remarks) Comm' with cutting weed and backing it down
 Saturday) at 2 pm finished cutting for the day went on land
 25th) got 1 hundred and 20 lbs of cork ready for use
 this day the then ascended Merchant Jule
 Mid Calus at 6 am took in raft of 100 lbs to fill
 at Meridian got it filled and began to raft this day

Remarks) Comm' with rafting at 1 pm got off 15 casks
 Sunday) at 2 pm got it in and began to run it down
 October 28) at 4 pm sent in a raft at 8 pm finished
 stowing down and washed off Mid Calus
 Mid Calus at 8 am sent all hands on shore for a
 run down this day

Remarks) Comm' with all hands on shore some drunk some fighting
 Monday) was out at 6 pm got all off had some trouble after
 October 29) they got on board to see who should be Master finally
 they found their mistake and put all right with the ship
 at 7 am went in for weed got off a boat load at 11 am
 3 men sick off duty 2 remaining one observed seen
 Mate Dick is rather hard working this day

Remarks) Comm' with strong weed at 3 pm got off small
 Tuesday) raft of water at 5 pm finished stowing water
 October 30th) and weed and washed off Mid Calus at 9 am sent
 8 men on shore to fill water still raining at 12 o'clock
 got 100 lbs off this day ended raining

Remarks) Comm' with rainy weather employed in stowing down
 Wednesday) water at 5 pm finished and washed off 30 End
 October 31st) the water 294 lbs two men sick Mid strong breeze
 at 7 am went on shore for more rainy weather and strong
 breeze at Meridian got off two boat loads all
 the weed and water off thank God

Bound March 1843

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Remarks) Comm' with cutting up weed and clearing
 Thursday) up decks ready for sea at 5 pm all ready
 November) wind not fair. Start in the morning at 8 am
 first light breeze took our cables and stood out to sea
 later part heading off the light air this day clearing

Remarks) Comm' with light breeze at 1 pm more ship in shore at
 Friday) 2 pm more ship off shore at 6 pm heading in shore
 bound up toward Ternberg Mid Calus at daylight
 ship twenty miles to toward of Solana under one corner from
 at 7 am more ship off shore latter light breeze employed in
 putting out a boat and heading out the run to sea

Remarks) Comm' with fine breeze ship heading off shore isle of
 Saturday) that dist 2 miles off the beam this light breeze at 1 pm
 November) more ship to the SE at daylight isle of St. 4 pts off the beam
 there strong current running to toward latter part employed in
 washing ship outside this day with strong breeze

Remarks) Comm' with strong breeze ship heading SE
 Sunday) at 10 pm took off shore at 2 am took in shore at daylight
 November 4th) St Helena on the weather beam dist 10 miles one ship
 1) leaving at anchor and a schooner on shore at 7 am took
 off shore land dist 2 miles at 10 am took in to sea

Remarks) Comm' with fine breeze at 4 pm ship off St Helena
 November 5th) at 4 pm took off shore at 7 pm heading in at 9 took
 off could not quite weather the St and strong current
 at daylight found ourselves 4 miles to windward of the St
 later part heading SE light breeze this day
