 8 by 8 at 6 pm tacked ship heading 8 by 8
 December 13th ship put heading 8 by 8 at 7 am tacked ship heading
 8 by 8 Emph'd in steering head stays this end right breeze
 Salt 11.54 Light 78.00

Tuesday Comm' with right breeze at 5 pm tacked ship
 heading 88 on right breeze ship right breeze
 December 14th the same can fish in light this end
 Salt 12.14 Light 78.04

Wednesday Comm' with right breeze same blackfish lowered without
 success ship put strong breeze ship heading 88 on later
 December 15th heading 88 on this end nothing in light
 Salt 13.08 Light 78.00

Thursday Comm' with whole sail breeze ship heading 8 by 8
 December 16th at 6 pm tacked ship heading 8 by 8 this end
 December 16th at 7 am tacked ship to the 2 on later put tacked to the Eastward
 Salt 13.14 Light 79.00

Friday Comm' with strong breeze at 6 pm tacked ship heading
 88 on one sail in light ship right breeze later the same
 December 17th heading 88 on nothing in light this end
 Salt 13.54 Light 80.00

Saturday Comm' with strong breeze ship heading 88 on at 5 pm
 December 18th tacked ship heading 8 by 8 all sail set
 December 18th ship and later the same strong breeze and ruggal to end
 Salt 13.47 Light 80.16

Sunday Comm' with strong breeze and thick ruggal weather
 December 19th ship heading 88 on at 4 pm same breeze 4 miles off
 December 19th off the weather clear at 4 pm lowered two boats
 and pulled to windward same the whales
 once out of the boats lost sight of them in a squall
 at 6 1/2 pm came on board whales going to windward
 ship put heading to the Eastward at 3 am tacked

Cruising On The Galloo Ground

Ship off shore strong breeze at daylight thick weather latter the
 same one fishhook in sight this end right sails in
 Salt 14.09 Light 80.09

Monday Comm' with strong breeze at 5 pm more ship
 December 20th to the Eastward at 5 pm ship increasing
 doubled reefed both in main course and
 speaker ship put right sail later more moderate
 heading to the Eastward this end thick weather
 Salt 13.31 Light 78.09

Tuesday Comm' with strong breeze same ship heading 88 on
 December 21st under double reef and courses ship the same
 December 21st later the same thick weather and ruggal as well
 at 10 o'clock saw a school of whales going to windward
 like Red this end

Wednesday Comm' with lowering two boats in chase of the
 December 22nd whales from them one rising and then came on
 heard same as usual from shore whales at 4 pm
 one Point on the lee horn coming to windward
 as if the Devere sent them lowered two boats
 again in chase to windward at 5 1/2 pm gave
 them up for the reason that we could not see
 them out of the boats at 6 pm got on board
 shortened sail heading East at 7 pm more ship off shore
 at 8 am saw a school of whales coming to board
 quick lowered 2 boats lowered struck the whole sounding
 and running hard strong breeze and ruggal at 10 am
 the other boats fastened to D having foul line at 12
 got him dead and took along side the other
 whales took off quick 8 1/2 this end
 Salt 14.15
