18th comm' with light breeze employed in  
Thursday) Painting yards at 6 pm went ship to  
Friday) the S.M. and strong breeze at 7 am  
9th 1861) more ship to the S. latter fine nothing  
in sight as usual this end  
Sat 12-13 9 am

19th comm' with strong winds nothing  
Friday) in sight at 6 pm went ship to the  
Saturday) in sight in light breeze and fine weather  
9th 1861) latter the same saw two carcasses of whales  
this end heading to the Eastward

Sat 12-14 Capt 84.05

20th comm' with light breeze nothing in sight  
Saturday) ship heading S. at 6 pm went  
Sunday) light breeze and light air at 7 am  
9th 1861) tacked ship to S. M. latter blackish in sight  
going quick to mindward this end  
Sat 12-15

21st comm' with light breeze ship heading to  
Sunday) the S. M. the same at 7 am went ship  
Monday) latter strong breeze nothing in sight  
10th 1861) latter  
Sat 12-16 Capt 83.67

22nd comm' with strong breeze ship heading  
Monday) latter nothing in sight and light air  
Tuesday) latter calm this end nothing in sight  
11th 1861) latter  
Sat 12-17

23rd comm' with calm ship heading to the S.  
Wednesday) the same latter part the same  
Thursday) one seal in sight this end

On the Galla Ground

24th comm' with strong breeze at 6 pm spoke  
Thursday) Mark John further and part heading S. S. W.  
at 6 am tacked ship heading S. E. at 11 am  
Saw 2 large whales coming to leeward then  
saw three boats at Meridian boat  
close on to the whale so end  
Sat 12-18

25th comm' with fine weather at 1 pm went  
Friday) boat succeeded in striking with one iron  
and it drove Starboard boat went on  
and struck the same whale whale  
still soon got his smoke pipe under way  
at 4 pm took him to the ship and began  
to cut his head at sundown got off on  
side made off fast for the night at daylight  
began to cut at 9 am got off head John Barber  
in sight whaling at 10 am saw 2 large whales  
off the weather then going quick to mindward  
saw 2 boats in chase did not see them but  
once from the boats at Meridian came on  
and began to cut this end

26th comm' with fine weather at 2 1/2 pm got in  
Saturday) latter got dinner at 3 o'clock on ground at  
4 1/2 pm got it in and heeled on side at 8 pm  
bailing case at 10 cleared up deck made seal  
feeding to S. M. at 1 am started the work on  
latter part running case strong breeze  
Ship heading S. W. so end
