 Wednesday at 3 1/2 pm came on breeze
 did not see the whale cut off the back
 the whole time clam binner and first
 heading to the East at 7 am more ship at 8 am
 one sail in sight one 1/2 in weather then at 9
 sent down main top sail to repair at 10
 and sent another at 10 am from the
 John Parker a whaling ship whale going
 forward at 11 the ship cut a small whale
 whale took off on the mind going like hell
 forward in chase thus end

Rem'd comm' with clearing at 2 pm whale
 Thursday going to mindward returned on board
 made all sail strong breeze and rigged
 at 6 pm whale cut 3 whales going by which
 the good Sunday went to the mind
 and first heading to the South under short sail
