17th sight but ship this end

Remarks Comm' with fine weather at 4 pm spoke barque
Monday afternoon of ship heading to the East and later
March 18th fine fine heading to the East later heading
nothing in sight but sails raise men for topsails
chances and main top of ship this end

Remarks Comm' with strong breeze ship heading to the East.
Tuesday Night mid night noon ship to the South side
March 19th increasing ship under short sail and strong breeze
later the same sent a old main top of sail
and condemned the other old one this end

Remarks Comm' with strong breeze at 4 pm spoke ship heading
Wednesday at 6 pm spoke ship heading to the East and
March 20th later light air nothing in sight this end

Remarks Comm' with thick weather ship heading East and
Saturday forenoon at 2 miles seen 12 minutes
light rose whals from our ship coming to
the surface which heard from the three ships
but not see them again went to the surface
quickly and strong breeze and squally later strong
breeze 4 ships in sight all hungry nothing in sight
