June 10th (Wed) Calm with light breeze from seaward ship heading 110° E
Tuesday the wind all day set thick foggy weather thick light air from
June 11th and best ship heading 110° E thick foggy weather to land
Left by D.S. 5417 Port by D.S. 5511 33

June 12th (Wed) Calm with calm and thick fog can't see one ship
Wednesday fought at 4 pm light breeze from seaward ship heading
June 12th wind increasing at daylight strong wind with thick weather took
in light sails at 10 am wind 18 m increasing doubled reefed
thick land with thick weather on observation

June 13th (Wed) Calm with squally weather wind 18 m ship heading 110° E
Thursday by the wind under doubled reef and courses at 5 pm
June 13th Calm a clear sky to the westward wind from increasing
to a light gale with large sea took in fore topsail and fore main
on 11 am ship steering 110° E under doubled reefed main and
and reef fore sail at 5 am set fore topsail closed reefed and
closed reefed the main thus land with thick weather

June 14th (Wed) Calm with slight gale from seaward at 8 pm observation
Friday course 110° E thick rainy weather can't see one ship's light
June 14th to can't make shore sail at midnight shade all sail
at 2 am wind increasing shortened sail to doubled reef
and reef main course at 9 am set single reef and strain
top gallant sail over at observation took in main top
squally weather wind west thus land

June 15th (Wed) Calm with squally weather from the westward view
Saturday watch employed in shubbing one staking in sail course
June 15th 110° E of compass variation 2 pts due fine steady breeze
carrying all sail at 8 am wind increasing took in light sails
thick weather ship heading 110° E wind 18 m
thus land

June 16th (Wed) Calm with strong wind and thick weather ship heading 110° E
Sunday wind 18 m at 4 pm wind increasing closed reefed at 4 pm
June 16th blowing a gale took in fore topsail and fore main
under closed reefed main topsail and fore sail shipped
a heavy sea master weather anchor in on the bow
secured it for the night at 6 pm took in fore topsail
during heavy gale from the north at 11 pm went to
the westward large sea running ship pitching heavy kept
up 110° E set 2 doubled reef topsails and fore course
at daylight made shore sail latter heavy squalls of
wind with light rain wind veering with closed reefed
sails in fore thus land

June 17th (Wed) Calm with squally weather took in fore topsail reefed
Monday fore sail to wind north with large sea
at 5 1/2 pm wind veered to 110° E kept off 110° E
set fore topsail quarter main under all the
time the strong steady breeze at daylight increasing
and veering to the north latter closed reefed light gale

June 18th (Wed) Calm with a gale from the north took in
Tuesday fore topsail large sea at 8 pm had a
hail Squared the first and the sarge
and part shore moderate made sail course
110° E wind in at daylight veered to 110° E with
thick weather hauled light sail and single
reefed latter ship by the wind heading 110° E

June 19th (Wed) Calm with squally weather closed reefed
Wednesday fore sail and reefed fore course ship heading
110° E by the wind at 6 pm took in fore topsail
at 2 1/2 pm wind veering to the westward set fore topsail closed
reefed fore course set 110° E light air from east
made sail latter thick and rainy thus land
