

Logg of Barque Greyhound of Westport

Monday Comm' with light gale from S.W. course 88° E. Ship sailing heavy deck continuously flattered with water at 4 pm June 27 Moderating. Took out one reef out main topsail set main top Gallant sail over at daylight. Ship was to the Eastward one watch beating out for hatter for for St. Pierre got it out and bent it and sent it up and set it. Later part light air from S.W. Cooper employed in making a pump to pump water out of the fore end after hatter thus end

Tuesday Comm' with light air from S.W. Ship had some confusion at work on the pump the watch stopping. Chafes at 7 pm calmer and cloudy weather nothing in sight this day. Ship part light buffing winds at 8 am light breeze from S.W. course 88° E. Set topsail. Wind sail later fine rain Cooper at work on the pump thus end

Wednesday Comm' with light breeze from S.W. course 88° at 3 pm. **Saturday** used to the South with fine clouds. Ship part fine light breeze from the South at 10. Set topsail. Strong watch. Lat breeze from 88° course 88° thus end

Thursday Comm' with whole sail breeze from 88° course 88° all day. **Wednesday** Set fine part strong steady breeze at 4 am ship went to the South North at 9 am. Ship bound to the Eastward and South at 10 am. Exchanged Longitude with Barque Godolphine of Bristol. Rantes France found our Chronometer to agree with Greenwich time within 8 miles. Thus end Ship heading N by the wind

Friday Comm' with strong whole sail breeze from 88° Ship at 3 pm 2 more sails in sight heading to S. **Monday** at 8 pm more ship heading 88° Ship part fine rain. **Tuesday** at daylight clear at 5 am squally this day found greenest spray in another place fished it with 8 line 14 yd hook and having any plank this end squally

Monday Comm' with squally weather rain almost heavy small 2 sails in sight at 6 pm double reefed head nine **Tuesday** wind due East. Ship heading 88° at 4 pm more ship heading 88° Ship light wind ship heading 88° at daylight. **Wednesday** Set sail heading 88° at 11 am wind overcast. Squared the yards. Sent down fore top gallant sail to repair this end
Lat 37.56 Lon 141.20

Thursday Comm' with light breeze from the westward all sail. **Wednesday** Set course 88° one watch repairing fore topsail. **Friday** Ship part light air from the westward. Latter the down finished fore top of sail and sent it this end fine air clear

Thursday Comm' with fine clear weather light air from the westward nothing in sight another second of fourth is passing away. Ship part light air from the west. Lake fine breeze one sail in sight course East. Thus end the glorious fourth of July

Friday Comm' with fine breeze from the north with clear weather course 88° Ship part strong breeze from S.W. course 88° at 3 am heavy rain at 10 am. Strong breeze latter more moderate thus end
Lat 38.52 Lon 142.36

Saturday Comm' with thick rainy weather this day found the men over run with Paddy. Since got up all their rags. **Sunday** started the work hatter them in pickel at 4 pm finished hatter. Calm down. Ship steady breeze from S.W. course 88° latter fine air clear one watch at work in the rigging. Thus end finished in sight
