Thurs (1st) Am' with strong wind and squally weather at 2 pm start Dundee in light sail double reefed being at 5 pm increasing (August 11th) took in fore and main courses Gell and Spanker were ship to sea that strong breeze at 10 am now ship to the East set fore sail St Helena being 1/2 3 in dist 20 miles nothing in sight rigger

Fri (2nd) Am' with strong breeze ship under double reef on (Monday) fore sail nothing in sight ship heading to the Eastward (August 12th) at night St Helena dist 12 miles at 3 am in sight at 11 pm were ship to sea that strong breeze ship under double reef nothing in sight thus end

Sat (3rd) Am' with strong wind and rigger at 2 pm were ship (Wednesday) to the Eastward St Helena being 1/2 3 in dist 20 miles (August 13th) one merchant ship in sight and one bird at 6 pm merchandise started out one reef set Gell and Spanker in strong wind at daylight first off for St Helena at 10 am left went on for the point will and coffee all out strong breeze went lost off St Helena of

Sund (4th) Am' with heavy squally double reef at 2 pm (Wednesday) in at 6 pm got within 4 miles could not (August 14th) fetch stand off for the night and back in ship under double reef main strong breeze being off and on like the same to end

Mon (5th) Am' with squally weather at 2 pm stood in (Thursday) Captain came on board steered out to the (August 15th) removal of the island that squally weather course on on like the same being in morning 1/2 3

Tues (1st) Am' with strong wind course on on one sail (Friday) single reef before mid night put the same (August 16th) after part wearing most employed in fishing foremast this end

Wed (2nd) Am' with light breeze course on employed in (Saturday) fishing foremast at 2 pm finished at 6 pm (August 17th) course on 2 3 courses but the same after part employed in cleaning ship inside for painting and setting up head stay thus end

Thurs (3rd) Am' with light breeze course on employed in (Sunday) down head rigging at 6 pm made all sail set (August 18th) sail and main courses but fine steady breeze at 6 am started a compass and found it at 8 am took in standing sail haul on the wind to the 8. m. hauling for wheels at American left off 11 nothing in sight 30 1/2

Fri (4th) Am' with fine clear weather course on on one sail (Monday) light at 6 pm set standing sail and main courses (August 19th) but fine steady breeze at 8 am sent down fore topmast and old foremast and bent our best ones little part getting point ready to point ship inside to end
