

Monday July 25th 1864
Spoke the bark pioneer and let them
have some bread and flour. the P
had taken nothing since leaving Flores
Lat 40° 00' N
Long 38° 36' W

Tuesday July 26th
Spoke the bark Janet Glanders of westport
40 days out with 50 blb sperm. also bark
plata 7 months out clean
Lat 39° 50' N
Long 39° 00' W

Tuesday August 2nd 1864
Spoke the bark colon Barstow 7 months
out with 370 blb humpback and 30 sperm.
No latitudes

Sunday Aug 7th
About 20 min past 5 AM raised a shoal of sperm
whales lowered down all the boat and made
chase. chased them untill 12 o'clock and
returned on board. About 4 pm lowered again
and chased but without success. at 1/2 past
6 lowered again and chased untill dark
and then we had to give it up

Wednesday Aug 10th
Spoke the bark
Lat 40° 00' N
Long 40° 33' W

Anaconela had Sunday Aug 14th
taken a 40 blb spoke the bark John Dawson cattle 26
whale 4 days days out with 60 blb sperm. also bark
previous. Plata Washburn nothing since last Report

Lat 31° 50' North
Long 40° 09' West

Tuesday Aug 16
Spoke the bark Sophie Bird Hagar 7 mos
out with 200 blb sperm. had lost about
300 blb from alongside

Friday Aug 26th 1864

About 1/2 past 12 raised a shoal of sperm
whales about 1 pm lowered and made
chase. at length the starboard boat struck
and succeeded in killing one. we took
him alongside about 1 1/2 pm.



He stowed down 35 blb Lat 39° 00' N
Long 43° 26' W

Saturday Aug 27th
While engaged in cutting the whale taken
the day previous raised another shoal kept
run of them untill we got through cutting
then lowered down and the waist boat struck
and succeeded in killing one. took him
alongside about 1 pm Lat 39° 00' N



He stowed down 15 blb Long 43° 26' W
Same day about sunset raised a large
whale going to leeward but did not lower

Wednesday Aug 31st
About 6 AM raised the bark Josh Bagdon
whaling about 1/2 past 7 saw the whale and
lowered the 2 starboard boats we moted with
them and made chase. the 3rd rising after
lowering the mate of the Bagdon went on
and missed the whale. very soon another
whale joined him about 3 pm our mate
went on the whale kicked and he did not
fasten. chased a while longer and returned
on board unsuccessful at 5 pm Lat 39° 20'
Long 44° 29'



Thursday Sept 1st
About 6 pm raised a shoal of small
whales of the weather beam lowered down and
chased untill dark and returned on board
Lat 39° 45' N
Long 45° 00' W
