captain & sailed to cruise one week
18th touches again took him on
board and sailed for the south
atlantic

Nov 10th 1865
Came to anchor in deep water
in wood and water and sailed
the 21st for south atlantic

Saturday Dec 8th 1866
Crossed the equator in longitude
22-10 W

Saturday Dec 22nd
At 1/2 past 6 Am raised a school
of small whales close to the ship
at seven lowered down the two harpoon
boats and made chase the make
struck one but soon got loose by
the Irons drawing

Sunday Dec 28th 1866 Cruising
At 10 Am raised a school of
small whales going to the
south east quickly lowered
all three boats, about 12 o'clock
the starboard boat went on to
one but did not get fast
chased them until sunset
and came on board

Jan 10th 1867 Cruising
About 4 pm raised a school of whales
12 lowered and made chase the
west boat soon struck but did
not get but one iron in and
that broke off close to the socket
chased until sunset and came
on board unsuccessful

Sunday Feb 4th
About 12 past twelve pm raised a
school of small whales going to the
south west at 12 past one lowered
all the boats and made chase
the starboard boat went on and
struck one killed and took her
alongside, chased the rest until
sunset without success

Monday March 11th
about 1/2 past 6 pm
raised a large whale
going quick to windward

Saturday Feb 9th
About 11 o'clock Am raised a
school of small whales going to
the N.W. At one o'clock lowered
all three boats, about 3 all struck
killed and took alongside four
of them

Lat 23-23 S
Long 37-08 W

Sunday March 11th 1867
about 3 pm came to anchor in
Barbados, sailed ship and sailed
the 25th for home
