raised a sperm whale under the
bow lowered down 2 quarter boats
but it coming dark did not
see them more
Lat 36° 23' N Long 36° 54' W

Tuesday Sept 7th
At 9th A.M. spoke Brig Eschol
Capt. of Beverly. Baling a 15 bl
whale taken on the 5th. At 6th 15th
P.M. spoke sch H. M. Simmons
Cook of Provincetown 14 months
out with 15 bls sperm oil.
Lat 36° 21' N Long 36° 20' W.

Thursday Sept 9th
Spoke schooner Louisa A. Senter
of Boston no report of oil.
Lat 37° 38' N Long 34° 45' W.

Saturday Sept 11th Sunday 12th
Monday the 13th off and on at
Flores. for recruits water &c &c.

Wednesday 13th Thursday 16th
Friday 17th off and on at Fygal

Spoke Bark Ware of A. B. Capt
Briggs 7 months out with 70 bls
Lat 29° 10' S. Long 44° 38' W.

Tuesday Dec 28th
Spoke Bark Balena Jennings
of Sag Harbour 26 months out
with 780 bls all told.
Lat 29° 25' S Long 45° 21' W.
