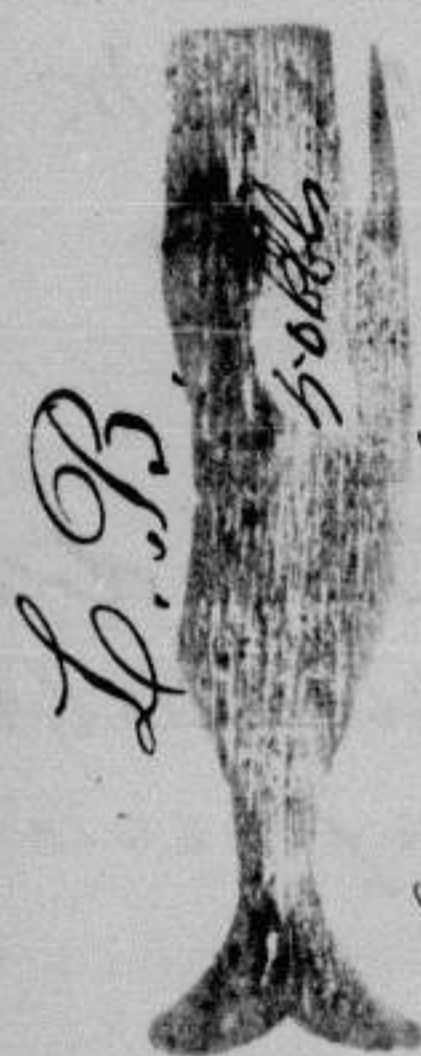


L.B.



Raised by John X

Sunday July 31st 1870
At 11:30 AM raised a school of large whales off our lee quarter breaching ran for them at one pm saw spouts at 1:30 PM lowered 2 boats & made chase at 2:45 PM the larboard boat struck one killed & took him alongside at 5:30 PM. He stowed down 51 bbls & 14 gals
Lat 39° 22' N Long 45° 33' W

Thursday Aug 4th

I went on board an English Bark named the Granter Grindell master from Isles river Eng^l for Charleston S. Carolina with trail road iron. sent a letter to wife got some books papers &c and came on board
Lat 29° 25' N Long 46° 10' W

Tuesday Aug 16th

I spoke bark E. Cooping, Cornell of New Bedford 17 months out with 750 sperm would be at home in Oct.
Lat 37° 31' N Long 47° 00' W

Friday Aug 19th

Saw a school of sperm whales scattered a great way. apart lowered down 3 boats and made chase for the nearest one the larboard boat struck killed and took him along side. we lost his junk the rest of him stowed down 90 bbls
Lat 38° 29' N Long 48° 23' W

Sunday Aug 21st 1870
Raised a school of small whales going to N.W. lowered 3 boats and made chase the S.B. succeeding in catching one that made about 10 bbls of oil
Lat 38° 04' N Long 48° 48' W
