

Friday, Sept 15<sup>th</sup> 1871

At 11 A.M. spoke the Bark *Arman* an *Gifford*  
of New Bedford 4 months out with 50 bbls  
spun Trawl having 6 2 miles off. Saturday  
16<sup>th</sup> off land on at *Fuzal*,

Tuesday, Sept 19<sup>th</sup>

Cruising off *Graciosa*. at 11 P.M. spoke  
Bark *Bry* Cummings of N.B. 3 months  
out clear,

Friday Oct 6<sup>th</sup>

At 5 P.M. came to anchor at the Island  
of *Teneriffe* got recruits & water & sailed  
the 14<sup>th</sup> for the south Atlantic,

Tuesday Nov 14<sup>th</sup>

At 10 A.M. spoke the bark *Helen* Near. Moor  
of N.B. 2 months out clear.  
Lat 15° 16' S Long 34° 25' W.

Wednesday Nov 22<sup>nd</sup>

At 4:30 P.M. spoke the Bark *Lacornia*  
Killy of N.B. 5 months out with 100  
spun.  
Lat 17° 54' S Long 36° 20' W.

Tuesday Nov 28<sup>th</sup>

At 10:30 A.M. raised a school of sperm  
whales at 12:30 lowered 2 boats & made  
chase at 4 P.M. lowered the 3<sup>rd</sup> boat chased  
until dark & give it up.  
Lat 17° 47' S Long 36° 25' W.

Wednesday Nov 29<sup>th</sup>

at daylight raised a school of whales if the  
weather being going quick to windward lowered  
2 boats & chased but could not overtake them.  
Lat 17° 51' S Long 36° 36' W.

Tuesday Dec 12<sup>th</sup>

At 4: P.M. raised a school of whales going quick  
to windward lowered all 3 boats & made  
chase chased until sunset & give it up.  
Lat 17° 40' S Long 36° 30' W.

Friday Dec 22<sup>nd</sup>

At 5:20 P.M. raised a school of sperm whales,  
going to N.W. lowered for them the 2<sup>nd</sup> being  
a merchant ship ran through them and  
drove them off.  
Lat 22° 39' S Long 36° 24' W.
