

Bark Grey Hound on a Whaling Voyage

Wednesday, 1

April 1 - 1881

This day Com Ship in Port but all Ready for sea got under way at four A.M. and stood off shore employed securing the anchor. Mid Part strong breeze Latter Part strong breeze and squally ship off an in the Isle employed lashing the anchors and stowing the Chain nothing in sight so ends this day

Thursday, 2

This day Com Ship strong breeze and squally employed painting the L. Boat and other jobs on board nothing in sight. Mid Part about the same Latter Part strong breeze and squally ship cruising off the Isle the Capt. on shore employed doing necessary work on board two sails in sight so ends

Friday, 3

This day Com Ship strong breeze and squally ship cruising off the Isle. The Capt. on shore employed doing necessary work on board nothing in sight. Mid Part strong breeze Latter Part more moderate ship off the Isle nothing doing on board nothing in sight

Saturday, 4

This day Com fine weather ship cruising off the Isle nothing doing on board nothing in sight. Mid Part about the same Latter Part off an in the Harbor sent a boat ashore after the Capt. but he did not come off he sent the Boat back with his trunk and other small things so ends this day

April 1881

Sunday, 5

This day Com Ship off and in the Harbor waiting for the Capt. the things of the man Porter came repairing it at four A.M. sent a boat in after the Capt. but he did not come off ship one boat steamed the Boat came off took her up and stood off shore. Mid Part light breeze Latter Part ship off and in the Harbor sent a boat in after the Capt.

Monday, 6

This day Com fine weather light breeze ship off the Harbor the Capt. came on board at four A.M. made sail and stood off shore. Mid Part moderate breeze Latter Part moderate and squally ship cruising off the Isle employed putting down some deck sheeting and other necessary jobs on board several sails in sight

Tuesday, 7

This day Com fine weather with light and baffling winds and haze employed making ship stay in board several sails in sight at sun down took in Light Sails. Mid Part about the same Latter Part moderate breeze sent in 7th Gib and repaired it and bent it again two sails in sight

Wednesday, 8

This day Com Hazy light breeze employed making L. Boat sail at sun down shortened sail. Mid Part about the same Latter Part fine weather employed doing ordinary ship stay in board one sail in sight
