This day Calm fine weather light breeze ship by the wind in the Eastern tack employed doing necessary ship's duty on board nothing in sight, (mid Part light breeze) Latter Part light breeze ship cruising for whales nothing in sight,

Monday, 25,

This day Calm fine weather light and calm nothing in sight (mid Part light breeze) Latter Part fine weather good breeze ship by the wind in the Eastern tack employed Repairing main Top Sail sail

This day Calm fine weather light breeze ship by the wind in the Eastern tack finished Top Sail sail, nothing in sight, (mid Part about the same) Latter Part ship on the S. tack employed Repairing the Fore sail nothing in sight

April, 1884

This day Calm fine weather light breeze employed finished the Fore Sail and Bent it and Bent the main Top Sail and main Top Sail nothing in sight, (mid & Latter Part strong breeze) ship by the wind in the Eastern tack employed Repairing Fore Top Sail sail.

Thursday, 28,

(Lat 9-54, S)

(Long 9-45, E)

This day Calm fine weather strong breeze ship by the wind heading to the westward finished the sail and bent it nothing in sight, (mid & Latter Part strong breeze) employed Repairing the main sail saw Black fish

(Lat 10-02, S)

(Long 8-25, E)

Friday, 29,

This day Calm strong breeze finished the sail and Bent it at sun down went on the Eastern tack nothing in sight (mid & Latter Part strong breeze) ship by the wind in the Eastern tack employed washing out the Fore Boats nothing in sight,

(No. 06)

Saturday, 30,

This day Calm fine weather strong breeze ship by the wind in the Eastern tack employed doing necessary work on board one sail in sight, (mid Part strong breeze) Latter Part fine weather ship by the wind in the Eastern tack employed Battering out stages nothing in sight,
