

Bark Suez Hound on a Whaling Voyage

Monday, 18. ^{July 1881} This day ship to anchor
all Hands on board nothing
saw. Latter Part three Boats off
but saw nothing.

Tuesday, 19. This day three Boats
off Cruising but saw nothing.
Boats came on board at Sun down
Latter Part four Boats Cruising
but saw nothing.

Wednesday, 20. This day four Boats
off Cruising saw two Whales Chased
but did not strike. Boats came
on board at dark. Latter Part
four Boats off Chased two Whales
but did not strike.

Thursday 21. This day four Boats off
Cruising saw two Whales going
quick did not get on Boats
came on board at Sun down
Latter Part four Boats Cruising
Chased four Whales but could
not get on.

Friday 22. This day four Boats off
Chased two Whales Struck one
to the L. Boat but the Iron
came out Boats came on board
at Sun down. Latter Part four
Boats off Cruising Chased four
Whales.

Saturday, 23. ^{July 1881} This day four Boats off
Cruising Chased three Whales going
quick and did not get on Boats
came on board at Sun down the
bark. Spray came to anchor along
side of us Boat taken 20, all
Wump back oil. Latter Part four
Boats off but saw nothing.

Sunday 24. This day four Boats off
Cruising but saw nothing at
dark. Boats came on board
Latter Part all Hands on board
July 25.

This day all Hands on
board nothing in sight from the
ship. Latter Part four Boats
off Cruising Chased several
Whales Struck to the L. Boat
killed the Whale and took him
along side the Boats off again.

Tuesday 26. This day two Boats
Cruising but saw nothing employed
on board cutting in the whale
when almost through in of the
cutting fol's parted and the
piece came down Breaking
Edward's Right Leg above
the knee. The Capt set this
by the Best he knew how and
he is getting along very well.
Latter Part three Boats off
Cruising but saw nothing.
