

Bank Long Hound in a Whaling Voyage

Wednesday, 27th July, 1841
This day three boats off cruising chased one whale but which did not get on board came on board at Sun down. Edward Call the man that had his leg broken is very comfortable to night. Latter part three boats off chased two whales.

Thursday, 28th
This day three boats off saw three whales employed on board. Boiling boats came on board at Sun down. Latter part three boats off chased whales struck to the L. Boat the H. Boat struck the large whale.

Friday, 29th
This day ship made way boats sent to two whales killed them and they both sank the ship came to anchor along side of one of the whales. Latter part walked up the L. Boat whale and commenced to cut.

Saturday, 30th
This day James had cutting the whale and boat by the sunken whale. Latter part two boats went up to the sunken whale walked him up and commenced going him to the ship.

Sunday, 31st July, 1841
This day towed the whale to the ship and cut him in latter part all hands on board cutting up the whale & boiling.

Monday, 1st
This day all hands on board James had cutting up the whale. Latter part two boats off employed stirring down & boiling.

Tuesday, 2nd
This day two boats off but saw nothing employed boiling. Boats came on board at Sun down. Latter part James had boiling ship under way working to the windward two boats off cruising.

Wednesday, 3rd
This day two boats that saw nothing the ship came to anchor. Boats came on board at Sun down. Latter part three boats off that saw nothing.

Thursday, 4th
This day three boats off cruising but saw nothing. Boat came on board at Sun down. Latter part two boats off that saw nothing employed on board stirring down & boiling.
