Sunday, 14<sup>th</sup> Aug. 1881  
 This day saw two  
 Boats off cruising saw several  
 Whales but could not strike boats  
 came on board at sundown  
 Latter Part all hands on board  
 nothing doing

Monday, 15<sup>th</sup>  
 This day ship at anchor  
 all hands on board nothing doing  
 Latter Part two boats off saw  
 several Whales struck to the  
 L. Boat killed the Whale and  
 commenced Dorying

 Boiling took the Whale along

 on board employed Boiling Latter  
 Part three boats off chased Whales  
 but could not strike

Saturday, 20<sup>th</sup>  
 This day saw two boats  
 off chased Whales struck to the  
 L. Boat killed him along side  
 Latter Part all hands on board  
 employed Boiling

Sunday, 21<sup>st</sup>  
 This day saw on board  
 Boiling and cutting in the Whale  
 Latter Part employed Boiling

Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup>  
 This day saw employed on board  
 Boiling the B. H. saw three came  
 to anchor along side of us first Part  
 finished Boiling Latter Part two  
 boats off but saw nothing employed  
 on board string down oil

Tuesday, 23<sup>rd</sup>  
 This day two boats cruising  
 but saw nothing boats came on  
 board at sundown Latter Part  
 two boats off but saw nothing emp-  
 on board string down oil
