1881. Lat. 11-25 " N. Long. 10-02 " W.
 May 11. Lat. 6-40 " N. Long. 7-20 " W.

 Monday, 12th Sept. 1881

This day light airs nothing
 doing on board at six P.M. came
 to anchor in 37 fathoms of water
 Latter Part ship under way working
 to the South. Started the Boiling

Tuesday, 13th This day came Boiling ship
 by the wind on the port tack
 Latter Part finished Boiling ship.
 Working to the Southward with all sail
 set. Nothing in sight

Wednesday, 14th This day came strong breeze
 at one P.M. Rose a Spearm Whale
 going quick toward three boats but
 the Whale was going to quick boats
 came on board, Latter Part ship
 working to the South employed doing
 odd jobs on board,

Thursday, 15th This day came ship by the wind
 working to the South at Latter Part
 stirring down oil in the after hold

Friday, 16th This day came ship by the wind
 working South nothing in sight Latter
 Part grasped stirring down oil in
 the fore hold
