Saturday 17. *Sept. 1881*
 This day com light
 wind ship working to the Southth
 employed setting up Casks. Latter
 Part about the same nothing in
 sight.

Sunday 18. This day com light
 wind ship working South finished
 the Casks. Latter Part the same
 nothing in sight (Lat 8⁰⁰, S
 Long 111⁰³, E)

Monday 19. This day com
 light wind ship on the S. track
 Latter Part good Breeze ship working
 in shore nothing in sight but N.B.
 (Lat 6⁴⁸, S
 Long 110⁰⁰, E)

Tuesday 20. This day com light
 wind rose the land at 11. Wind
 Part came to anchor 10 fathoms
 of water. Latter Part good boats
 off chased several Whales & Boat
 had one missed.

Wednesday 21. This day com good boats
 off chased several Whales but could
 not strike boats came on board
 at sun down. Latter Part three
 boats off chased several Whales
 but could not strike.

Thursday 22. This day com three boats
 off chased several Whales but could not
 strike boats came on board at
 sun down. Latter Part three boats
 off chased several Whales but did not
 get on.

Friday 23. This day com three boats
 off chased three Whales but did not
 strike boats came on board at sun
 down. Latter Part got under way
 for the O. S. & P. station. Three
 boats off.

Saturday 24. This day com three boats
 off chasing saw one Whale boats came
 on board at sun down. Latter Part
 got under way with the ship rose a
 goodly haul. Three boats struck
 the Wh. Boat killed the Whale
 and took her along side came to anchor
 in 8 fathoms of water.

Sunday 25. This day com all hands on
 board cut in the Whale. Latter
 Part employed cutting up the Whale
 and getting ready to boil.
