light breeze nothing in sight Leather
Part moderate breeze employed
doing messary work, nothing in sight
(Lat 5-56. S
Long 7-15. E)

Sunday, 9. This day Com.
light wind ship cruising employed
doing ordinary ship's duty. Leather Part
light wind ship by the wind
nothing in sight nothing on board
(Lat 6-00. S
Long 7-25. E)
