Sunday June 4th

This day good weather steering to the westward
lat 9.37 S lon 11.24 E

Monday June 5th

This day was good weather see black fish laying on port tack heading to westward

lat 9.27 S 9.43 E
Mr Pohochocianowski was released to day from deck and had his watch below as he has served his full time of punishment so ends

Tuesday June 6

This day was pleasant breeze from south with heavy swell from south laying on starboard tack heading to the south east

lat 9.20 S lon 9.18 E

Wednesday June 7th

This day pleasant breeze with heavy swell from south steering east

took in sail at night and came to on starboard tack

lat 9.13 S lon 10.42 E

Thursday June 8th

This day was good weather see black fish and a fin back at night took in sail and lay on starboard tack heading to the south east

lat 8.46 S lon 10.22 E

Friday June 9th

This day was pleasant weather steering to the east all day at night took in sail and lay on starboard tack all day at work setting up rigging

lat 8.19 S lon 10.53 E

Saturday June 10th

This day good weather see a fin back

at night took in sail lay on starboard tack till all day employed in setting up rigging so ends

lat 8.22 S lon 11.04 E

Sunday June 11th

This day was calm all day employed in working in rigging see black fish

lat 8.31 S lon 11.22 E
